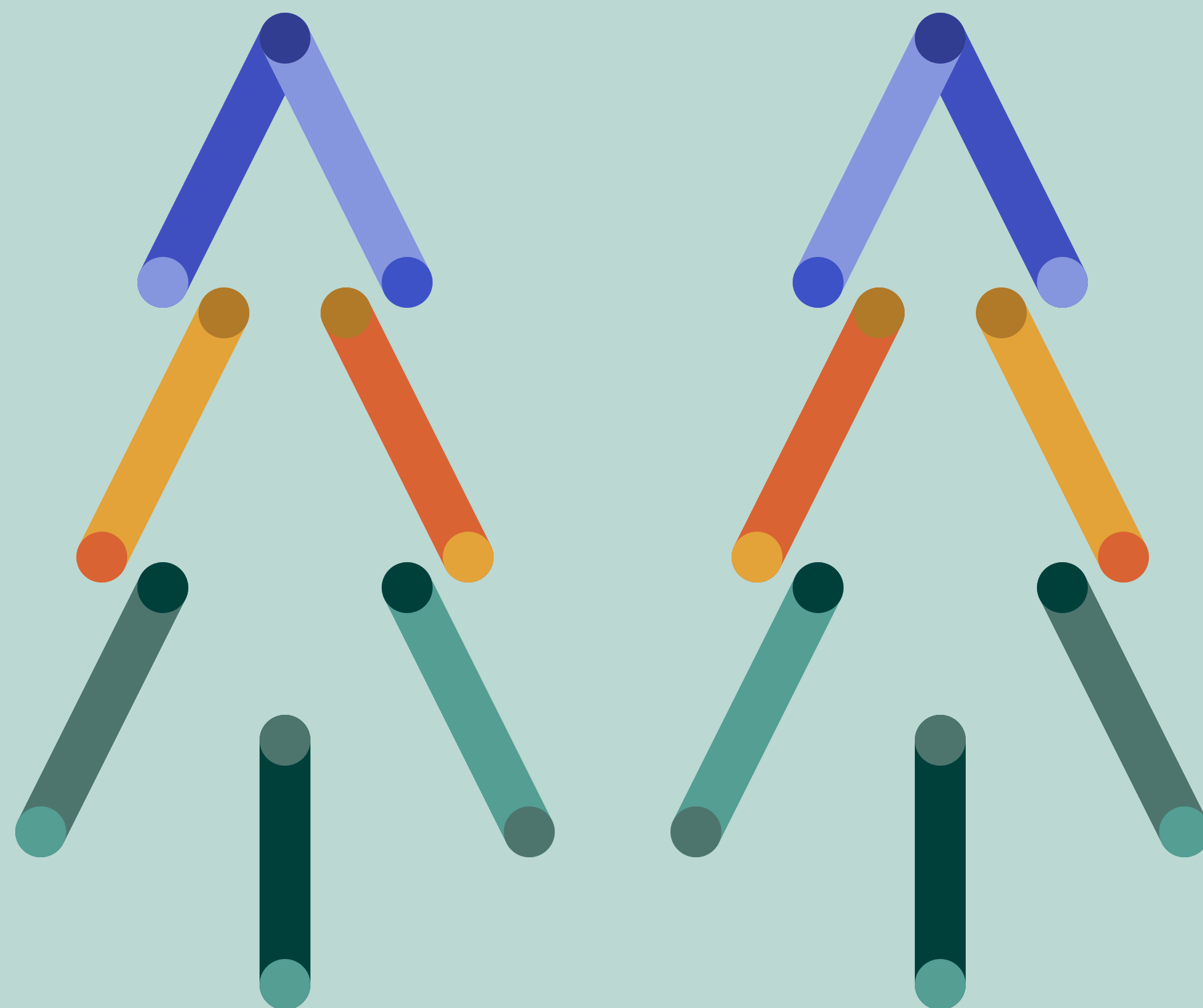

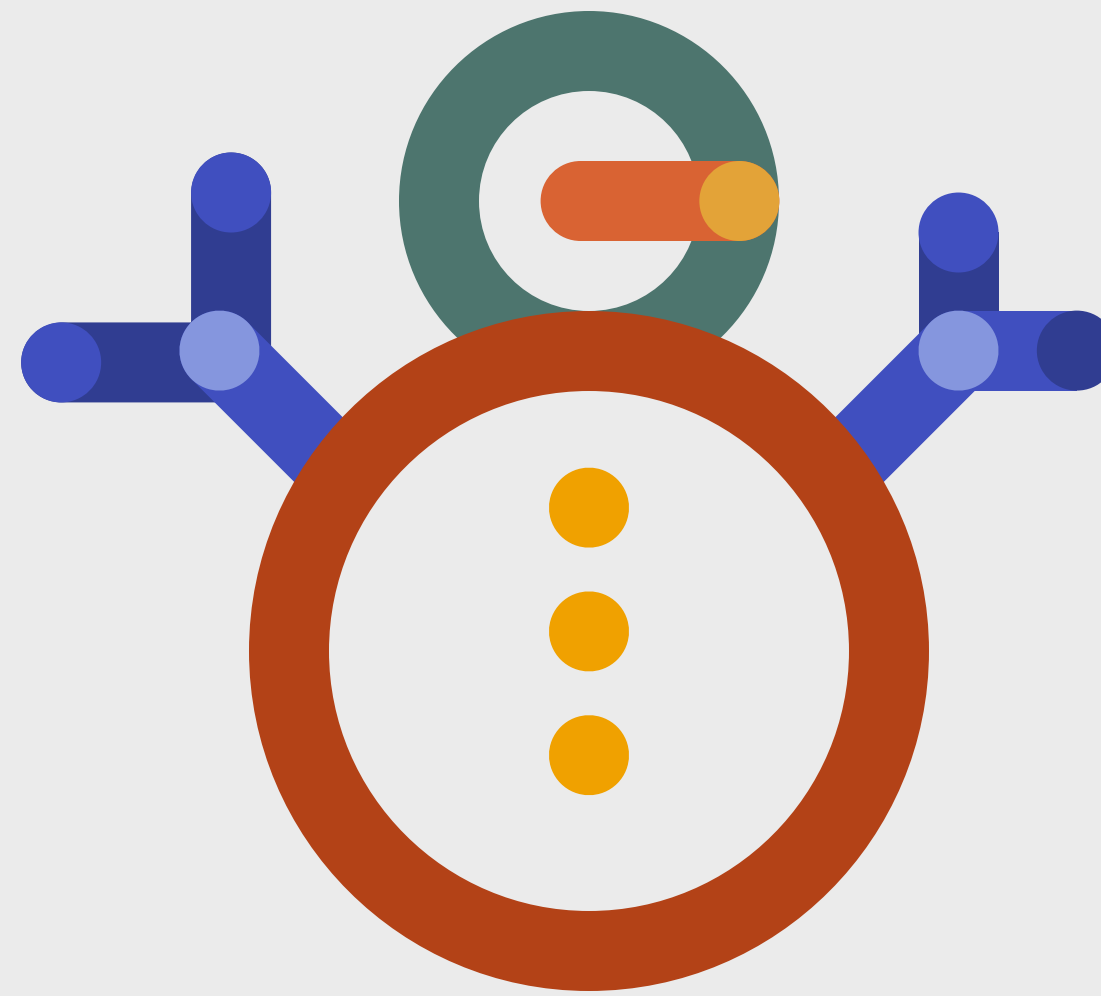

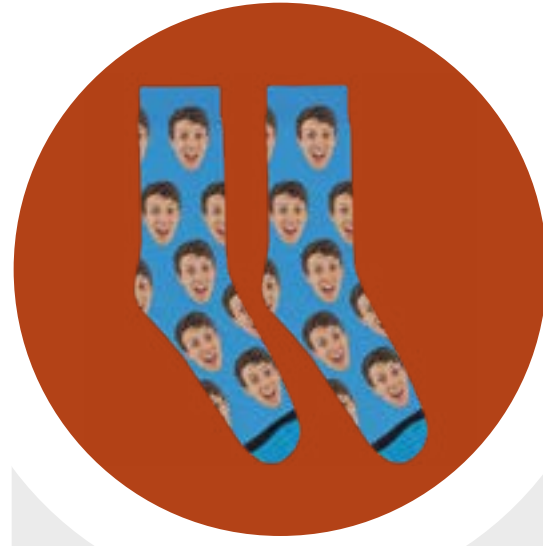
A card game that's a little more fun than the real thing

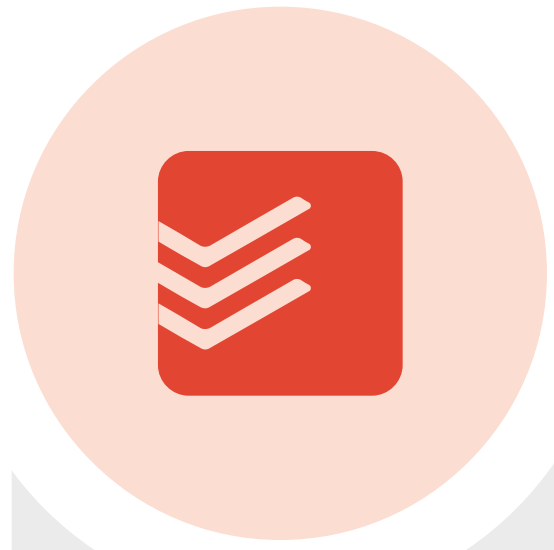
